



The Ode

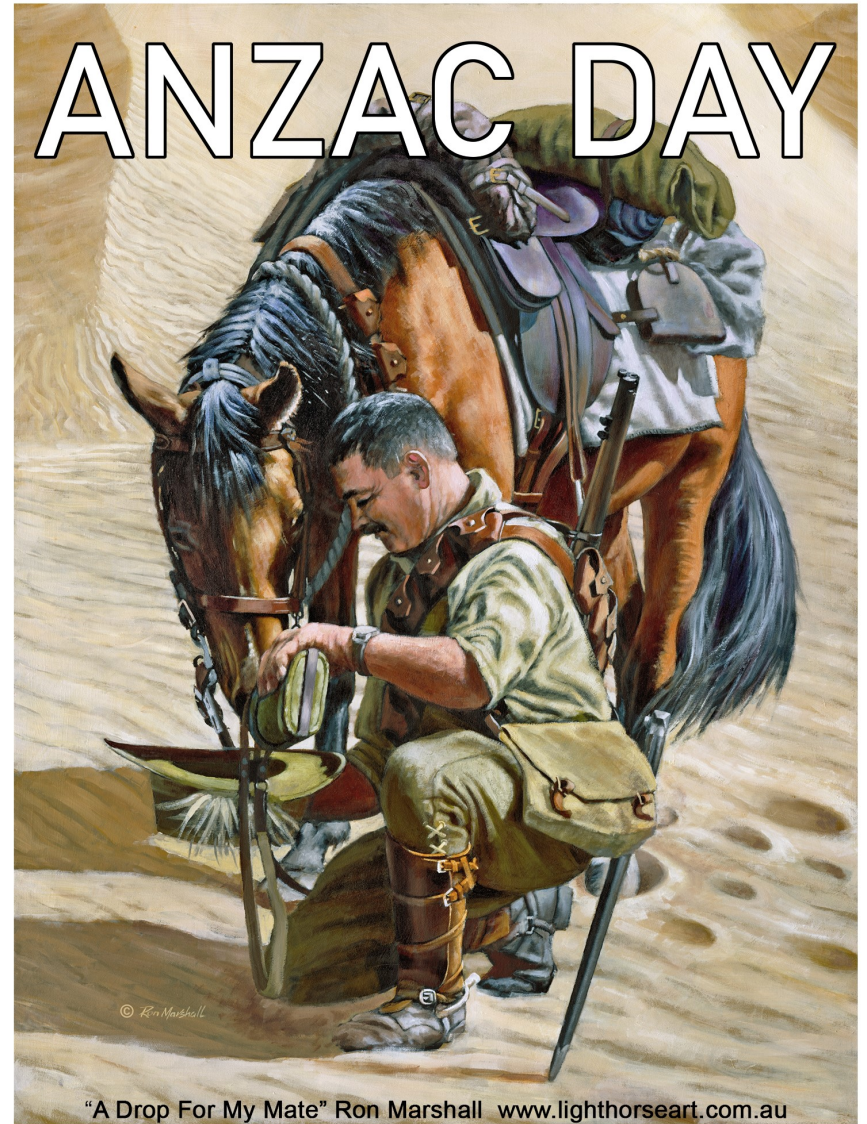
They shall grow not old,
