Executive Summary

Total revenue of \$120,718.80 as of the end of July reflects an increase in both cremations and burials and this represents 13% of the annual budget.

Total year to date expenses of \$72,287.65 is 8% of the annual budget.

Final accruals and end of year reconciliation are still outstanding. Financial year results will be reported in Council's Annual report by November 2020.
