Proposed Declaration of Dog Restriction Area – Asche

Notice is hereby given that Litchfield Council proposes to declare the suburb of Asche a Dog Restriction Area pursuant to Section 23 of the Litchfield Council (Dog Management) By-Laws 2017.

If declared, the restriction would limit all properties in Asche to a maximum of two (2) dogs, unless a licence is granted by Council.

Asche is a newly established suburb within the Greater Holtze development and is not yet occupied. The area will comprise approximately 544 residential lots (average size approximately 450m²) with low-medium and medium density zoning and interconnected community parks as well as commercial areas proposed for the Territory Reserve Parcel.

The proposed restriction aims to proactively support community wellbeing in a high-density environment by:

- Reducing the risk of excessive barking and noise complaints
- Minimising odour and waste concerns
- Preventing dog overcrowding and promoting animal welfare
- Providing clear expectations for future residents.

Introducing the restriction prior to occupation will avoid retrospective enforcement issues.

You can provide feedback on the proposed Declaration of Dog Restriction Area, Asche from Monday, 23 February 2026 until 5pm on Monday, 23 March 2026.
